Menus and Mealtimes



Adhering to the new EYFS nutrition guidance (a statutory safeguarding and welfare requirement) we are emphasising the importance of routine, balanced menus, adults role modelling and involving children in the mealtime process.

We aim to structure our mealtimes to ensure they are a positive experience with a focus on health and safety. We focus on promoting nutrition, a social learning opportunity and supporting the all round well-being of the children.

Key principles of our menus

Breakfast is 8:00-8:30 we offer a different option every day including cereals (that are labelled green only), porridge and yogurt and fruit.

Snack time is around 10am and 2 pm it involves a light snack following the nutritional guidance on portion sizes and a focus on fruit vegetables and some bread products.

Lunch is a hot meal at 11:30 for under threes and the Dragonfly room and 12:00 for the Busybees. We use Halal meats and lots of vegetables. Meals are produced on site. If children do not eat the meal provided we do offer alternatives.

Tea is a light meal either cold or warm. We do recommend you consider a snack or light super when your child returns home as this is a very light meal.

Any allergy requirements please inform staff or simply update on Blossom

This term we are offering a wider range of sessions and aiming to meet the needs of parents. We are currently unable to offer an earlier start than 8:00am as there is no uptake at present however if we have a list of parents wishing to use the 7:30am slot we will re-look at this.

If your sessions are not fully meeting your needs have a chat with a member of the management team and we will see what we can do. We are aiming to be as flexible as possible however we must keep with the staff to child ratio's and staff working hours.



We would like to remind all parents not to park on the yellow lines at either sign of the nursery entrance as this is causing an obstruction. Also please do not park over the nursery entrance or people's drives for drop off or collection.

Please drive slow and careful into the nursery car park and watch out for children, parents and staff walking about!
